

E-news letter:

Stray cattle were moved to 'Goshalas':

The City's people are facing troubles due to stray cattle, as the stray cattle are causing traffic problems in the city and sometimes hurt the commuters and pedestrians. Around 700 cattle are there in the city, among 80% of them are stray cattle. The cattle owned by the people, are not feeding the cows properly due to their financial problems and even they don't have sufficient place to provide shelter to them, that's why the owners of the cattle leaving the cattle to roam on the city's roads freely. The stray cattle frequently graze in the gardens and plants which were planted by the Municipal Corporation authorities at several places and pass urine and dung on the roads, which make the city untidy. The people in the city complained over this issue to the authorities for several times. As a move to take action against this issue, the Municipal Corporation authorities are capturing and shifting the stray cattle to Tirupati Goshala. As per the information provided by Sri Jagannadham, Sanitary Inspector, Chittoor Municipal Corporation, around 30 stray cattle were shifted to Tirupati Goshala and 25 owners of them were fined above Rs. 10,000/- for making the cattle stray till date.



Rs. 50 lakhs tax was collected on the last day of the Financial Year:

The total annual tax and tax dues for the F.Y. 2017-18 of Chittoor Municipal Corporation was Rs. 18 crores. Out of Rs. 18 crores for F.Y. 2017-18, Rs. 11.74 crores taxes were collected by the Corporation authorities upto 31st March 2018. In one day alone i.e. on the last day of March 2017, Rs. 50 lakhs taxes were collected by the Corporation authorities. This year tax collections are more than the tax collections of the last year with an exceeded amount of Rs. 49 lakhs.

Disbursement of pensions to newly enrolled beneficiaries by the Mayor:

Sri Katari Hemalatha, Mayor of Chittoor Municipal Corporation, distributed the NTR Social Security Pensions to the newly enrolled beneficiaries for the month of April 2018 at 31st and 49th Divisions of Chittoor Municipal Corporation. While speaking on it, the Mayor has said that the pension scheme is benefitting to the weaker sections of the society.

Complete the works by December ending –Collector :

Considerations worth of Rs. 12.65 crores :

The Commissioner of Chittoor Municipal Corporation has conducted a press conference on SC-ST sub-plan. In the meeting, the Commissioner has said that actions have been taken to provide basic amenities in SC colonies under SC - ST sub-plan. In this connection, the Commissioner also said that considerations have been submitted to the Government for 145 types various developmental works under SC-ST sub-plan worth of Rs. 12.65 crores, under 14th Finance Commission Rs. 75 lakhs worth of works and from General Funds Rs. 69 lakhs. The Commissioner further said that Tenders had been invited for Rs. 10 crores of works but no Contractor came forward for called tenders ; developmental works worth of Rs. 1.65 lakhs have been completed and bills has sent to the treasury for sanction ; work orders have been issued worth of Rs. 3 crores ; Rs. 1.35 crores worth of works like laying of roads, construction of sewerage canals are under progress.

Follow and implement model code of conduct :

On 24.04.2018, Sri Pradyumna, District Collector conducted a meeting at meeting hall in Collectorate with representatives of the political parties and authorities, regarding implementation of model of code of conduct in view of the bye elections to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council. Election Commission has released the schedule for APLC election which is to be held from 21st April. The Collector has instructed to all the representatives of the political parties and authorities to follow and implement model code of conduct which is in force from 21st to 29th of this month. The Collector also instructed the attendees of the meeting to not to display any hoarding, banners, cut-outs regarding publicity of any political party and against to the any opposition party, as per the provisions of model code of conduct.

Special drive on sanitation works :

Under the supervision of Sri G. Balasubramanyam, Commissioner of Chittoor Municipal Corporation, a special drive has been conducted to remove weeds on roads, clearing blockages in sewerage canals, sweeping of roads, fogging to get rid of mosquitoes etc. in 1, 4, 5, 17, 20, 23 and 30 divisions.



5% rebate on property tax :

The authorities of Chittoor Municipal Corporation announced that there will be 5% rebate on the payment of advance Property Tax for the F.Y. 2018-17, on or before 31st April 2018. This is applicable to all the property owners who pay the full property tax in one or two installments within in the said due period.

Transfer of Municipal Commissioner :

Sri Gudimallam Balasubramanyam, Commissioner, Chittoor Municipal Corporation was transferred to his home department State Employment Office, from where he was transferred to Chittoor Municipal Corporation on deputation as his deputation period was terminated.

Make proper arrangements for Basketball competitions – JC-2 Chandramouli:

On Tuesday, Sri Chandramouli, JC-2 inspected the ongoing arrangements for Basketball competitions at DSA grounds. After the inspection, the JC-2 conducted a review meeting with the concerned officials and ordered the officials to make proper arrangements for national wide basketball competitions which is scheduled to be held from 1st May to 6th May. The JC-2 also ordered the concerned official to look after preparation of food, arrangement of basketball courts, flood light arrangements, galleries formation, maintenance of toilets, street lights and preparation of invitation cards etc. In this meeting Lakshmi, DSDO, President of Basketball Association State, Chief Coach have and others have participated.
